State SSI Income – Where to look for it

Why should I worry about it?


If we fail to correctly determine if a client is receiving State SSI, it could mean a big overpayment, and nobody wants that. And data exchanges do not pick up State SSI payments automatically like they do other Social Security payments.

What cases are affected?


Any case that receives even a dollar of federal SSI. This includes family and EBD cases. If a case receives federal SSI, they are automatically eligible for State SSI, and should be checked.

How do I check?


Glad you asked! Here's an example of a case that receives a federal SSI payment:



We should use the member's MAID number to check in Forward Health to see if the client receives a State SSI payment. (Look under Query/Case Member History to find the MAID number) Then enter the MAID into Forward Health under IC Functionality/Member Search:




The check under the SSI Payment History tab:



And hit the 'search' button without entering a date. You should see a display of the member's SSI payment history. The following shows a case that has been receiving the State SSI payment (usually \$83.78)



This income should then be entered manually on a new UI screen with a verification code of DE:
