
What is a Child Care Assessment

 A Child Care Assessment is a discussion between the worker and the parent to determine how many child care hours the parent needs to participate in their approved activity.

Why do we do the Child Care Assessment?

- We do the assessment to ensure that we **collect all the required information** needed in order to enter in a child care authorization.
- What does the parent need for childcare for them to participate in their approved activity.
